Numeracy small group intervention	Maths HLTAs employed to carry out small group interventions on all pupils who came into the Academy achieving a score below 100.	£10 000	Target of 80% of all students receiving intervention to make expected progress and bring in line with ARE. By the end of the year 100% made progress.		
Reading recovery	Pupils receive 1:1 or small group reading support if they enter the Academy with reading ages below 9, with English HLTAs.	£20 000	Target of increase of 2 years (at least 18 months) to be reached. 100% made progress with 60% making more than expected.		
Literacy Intervention programme	Pupils who enter the Academy with reading score below 100 at KS2 receive extra support from class teacher and HLTAs in literacy/numeracy within the curriculum and outside school hours.	£7000	100% made progress.

DEAR	Year groups 7-10 gaining 20 minutes each day of extra reading time. Weaker readers spend DEAR time within small groups with HLTAs.	£1000	Target of increase of 2 years (at least 18 months) to be reached.
