## Red Nose Day - Friday 15 March 2019

As you are probably aware, Comic Relief takes place this year on Friday 15 March. I am writing to inform you that in support of our continuous charity fundraising ethos, the school will host several non-uniform days per year in support of a charity. This term, we have decided to hold our non-uniform day to support Comic Relief.

We are extremely proud of our students, who are always willing to engage enthusiastically in charity based events. This year all our charity fundraising events have been a huge success. We have already raised money for MacMillan Cancer Support through a coffee morning, supported the Poppy Appeal in November and held Christmas Jumper Day on 21 December, which raised £695.72 for Pontefract Food Bank.
