I would like to take this opportunity to draw your attention to The King's School Uniform Guide which is applicable from September 2019.

As part of our drive to improve outcomes for our students, we expect them to be smartly dressed. A well-worn uniform supports excellent behaviour, equality amongst our students and reflects the pride that our students have in being part of our school.

As a result of direct feedback from parents/carers, we have returned to using local stockists and further information can be found in the guide you will receive with this letter. Please pay particular attention to the Important Changes section. We appreciate that it can be difficult to find generic clothing that is suitable so as a result have introduced a new mandatory logoed skirt. This will ensure consistency for our students and make it easier for parents/carers to purchase the required uniform. I am also pleased to introduce the alternative fleece option for PE. This is again as a result of feedback and I have no doubt will be an attractive and popular choice for many. Students will need to be wearing all newly logoed items in September following the initial introduction to this at the start of the academic year.

We plan on having a day towards the end of the summer term where members of staff will be available in school so you can check any specifics around the uniform. This will ensure all requirements are met at the start of the academic year. We will send a text message with the specific dates and times.
