Introduction

What is enrichment?

Although lessons end at 3.05pm, the school day does not. Students can choose from a wealth of after-school enrichment activities and clubs, both academic and nonacademic.

Sessions are typically 3.05pm – 4.05pm.

Why attend enrichment?

Whether you want to improve your depth of knowledge or need help with specific work then sessions can provide you with tuition from a range of staff in different departments. Enrichment activities allow you to gain experience and skills in areas not typically part of your everyday curriculum or life experience. Enrichment can encourage you to work outside of your comfort zone, develop resilience and meet new people. Gaining new experiences is both enjoyable and desirable to future employers and higher education providers.

The enrichment programme is linked to the Key Stage 3 Graduation for new Year 7s only. Use your planner to record your attendance at sessions so these can be transferred into points towards your Graduation total.

Who can attend?

Everyone! Whatever year group you are in, there are a huge range of sessions to choose from. Some activities are specifically targeted at individual year groups or key stages and this information is provided in this booklet. Some enrichments may provide great opportunities to make friends in other year groups.

What is available?

Whatever your needs or interests, there are lots of activities to be involved in. The selection of activities we offer are organised for you, by day. If there is an enrichment you would like to take part in that isn't currently offered, please mention it to Mr A Holland.

What happens if an enrichment has to be cancelled or changed?

Occasionally enrichment sessions may need to be cancelled, such as when there is bad weather. You will be made aware of this at the very first opportunity so that you can plan your journey home.

Achieve

Achieve is taught time with specialist teachers from all subjects delivered to Year 11s. Sessions are intended to catch up or consolidate skills and knowledge needed for coursework and or the exams. If students are selected, attendance is necessary.
