



Live Online Lesson Timetable - w/c 06.07.2020 – ALL YEAR GROUPS

- Years 7-9 live online lesson day/s and time/s will remain the same each week, wherever possible. Core subjects are now delivering TWO live online lessons per week. The first lesson of the week is indicated by (1) and the second lesson of the week is indicated by a (2).
 - Year 10 live online lesson days and times will alter each week.
 - Class teachers will direct pupils to live online lessons by adding the day/s and time/s of the lesson into the instructions on SMHW each week.

There will also a 1 hour live online lesson for Year 10 Computer Science students on Monday 6 July from 3.30pm – 4.30pm





Pupils can access their live online lessons through Google Classroom using a function called 'Meet'. Pupils should follow the instructions below to access the live online lessons for subjects they study.

- 1. Log in to Google Classroom using existing Google Classroom email address and password.
- FOR EACH SUBJECT... Join the live online lesson Google Classroom using the specific code provided by the subject teacher in SMHW.
 Pupils who joined a live online lesson for a subject last week do not need to join this Google Classroom again for that subject.
- 3. The day/s and time/s of the live online lesson has been shared by subject teachers on SMHW and are in the timetable above.
- 4. Just before the live online lesson starts the pupil should ensure they are logged into Google Classroom and go to the correct live online lesson classroom. Once the teacher is ready to begin the lesson they will unhide a link which the pupil should then click on to join the lesson.
- 5. Pupils should message their subject teacher on SMHW if there are any issues or use the 'How to Guide' which can be found on the home learning page of the school website.

Pupils should adhere to the following expectations or they could be removed from the sessions.

- 1. Pupils should wear appropriate clothing, although this does not have to be school uniform.
- 2. Pupils should mute themselves at the start of the session; there will be opportunities to unmute to ask or respond to questions during the session.
- 3. Pupils should not interrupt or disrupt the session in any way; if repeated after **one** warning, they will be removed from the session.
- 4. Pupils should be on time for the session, and not join part way through.
- 5. Pupils should have a pen and paper ready to make any notes or complete tasks.
- 6. If requested, students should complete any pre-reading or questions before the session.

Please note that **all sessions will be recorded** for safeguarding purposes and stored securely. Families should be aware of the camera in the room and consider ensuring students have a space without noise or distractions for their lesson time.
