Year 11 Mid-Year Report and Mock Results

To access your child's Year 11 Mid-Year Report please view the Reports tab on your My Child at School Account. An explanation of this report is set out below;

- The Year 11 Target indicates the minimum GCSE grade we expect your child to achieve in Year 11.
- The Mock is the exact grade achieved in the exam completed before Christmas. This grade is awarded within a pre agreed national boundary. If your child did not do take a mock exam in this subject the box will be shaded grey.
- The REG is the realistic expected grade we think your child should achieve at the end of Year 11, based on the most recent summative assessment, classwork and their Attitude to Learning (ATL).
- The ATL scores indicate your child's overall grade in each subject area and ranges from a "1" (Exemplary) to a "4" (Often fails to meet expectations) The colour code indicates how much progress your child has made in comparison to their start point at the end of Key Stage 2. A key is included at the bottom right of the report.
- A "Y" will appear in the homework column if there is an issue with completing homework to a suitable standard or if it is not completed on time.

We recognise that excellent attendance is key to good progress and attainment. In light of this, your child's current attendance is included within the report.
