Unfortunately, due to circumstances beyond our control, we were unable to provide parents with their appointments yesterday afternoon. This was due to a system fault with our provider, SchoolCloud. It is incredibly frustrating for all concerned and I offer my apologies this was not able to take place. As you can imagine, we and a number of other schools nationally have sought assurances that this will not happen again.
