

## The King's School – Summer School

The King's School offered a 5-day summer school in August 2021 for students making the transition from Year 6 to Year 7. There was a total of 49 students in attendance. The summer school included a mixture of academic sessions and enrichment activities.

Aims of the summer school:

- To enable students to meet their peers and build relationships.
- So that students could familiarise themselves with the new school setting.
- Allow students to meet staff and build relationships prior to starting Year 7.
- Ensure students are given the opportunity to catch-up in English & Maths.

<b>Academic Sessions</b> Students received academic tuition in English & Maths from specialist tutors to catch-up on core skills in preparation for their start in Year 7.	£3,500.00
<b>Enrichment Activities</b> Activities provided by experienced staff to encourage students to build relationships with peers and get to know staff and the school.	£551.40
<b>Educational Sessions</b> Students received sessions run by teaching staff in Science, Music and PE	£1,564.20
<b>Rewards</b> Rewards provided throughout the week to highlight student achievement.	£243.00
<b>Catering</b> Food and drink provided for students during summer school.	£854.08
<b>Additional Resources</b> Equipment provided for students during academic sessions.	£725.98
<b>Leadership</b> Staff leadership time to lead, coordinate and supervise summer school.	£1,500.00
