Year 11	Macbeth by William Shakespeare and Language Paper 1 and 2 Pupils will recap plot, characters, themes and context of their GCSE Shakespeare text. They will improve the crafing of their essays and work on timing, pace and stamina, looking at past exam questions. Students will work on exam technique and timing. Further revision of the Language papers is a regular feature throughout the year. It becomes more bespoke per class, after question level analysis.
