Year 11 October Half-Term Workshops

At The King's School we aim to ensure that students have as much access to support as possible in order to achieve the best possible outcomes at the end of Year 11.

We have organised a number of teacher-led sessions that will take place during half-term for targeted students. This is a fantastic opportunity for students to access specialist support and resources to catch up and improve their coursework, and/or prepare for upcoming mock exams.

Coursework Workshops

The timing of these is critical as some coursework elements are due to be completed before the end of the year and so this is the final opportunity outside of normal school hours to ensure they are completed. This will also mean students have more time to concentrate on preparation for their mock exams due to take place in November/December.

Language Workshops

We will also be offering two workshops for Languages, one for Foundation Tier and one for Higher Tier, which are aimed at supporting students to prepare for their speaking mock exams due to take place in November.

Parental Support & Consent


