Next Steps

- **Attendance:** Undoubtedly, attendance is vital for academic success. Research shows that students with excellent attendance have a higher likelihood of achieving their academic goals. To maximise learning opportunities leading up to the exams, we strongly encourage 100% attendance from now until the exam period and appreciate your support in ensuring your child attends school every day. Consistent attendance will ensure that your child does not miss out on vital learning and exam preparation.
- **Revision:** We recommend that all Year 11 students spend a minimum of 2 hours after school revising. This might take the form of independent revision or completing homework, which will serve as revision to consolidate key learning.
- **Parent/Carer Evening:** We encourage your attendance on Thursday, 1 February, for a detailed discussion of your child's results and teacher feedback. Please follow the instructions in the letter you've received for online appointments on School Cloud.
- **Achieve Sessions:** Achieve sessions will continue to take place up until the final exams and are crucial for your child's success. Your support in ensuring their attendance is invaluable.
- **February and Easter Workshops:** Certain subject areas will be offering February or Easter revision workshops or days to enhance coursework. If your child is to attend a workshop, you will receive

another letter. We appreciate your support in ensuring your child attends any workshops they are requested to attend.

- **Revision Festival:** Save the date for a face-to-face Revision Festival scheduled for Monday, 26 February. Further details, including key revision materials and guidance for parents and students, will be shared soon.
