Year 11 Mid Year Report

Please log in to your My Child At School (MCAS) account to view your child's mid year report. To access it please view the reports tab.

Teachers have used mock exam results, key marked piece assessments as well as classwork and homework to report on your child's attainment and progress. We look forward to discussing your child's progress in school and their report at parents evening later this week.

An explanation of the report is set out below:

The Report Breakdown:

- The Attitude to Learning (ATL) scores indicate your child's ATL in each subject area and ranges from a "1" (Exemplary) to a "4" (Often fails to meet expectations).
- Year 11 Target indicates the minimum GCSE grade we expect your child to achieve at the end of Year 11.
- The Mock grades are those achieved during the written mock exams. This does not include any practical elements of the course. (X) indicates that a mock exam/s took place but the student missed all or some of the exam/s in that subject. A grey box indicates that there was no mock exam/s in that subject.
- The REG is the realistic expected grade we think your child should achieve at the end of Year 11, based on the most recent summative assessment, classwork and their Attitude to Learning (ATL). The colour code indicates their progress towards achieving or exceeding their target.
- A "Yes" will appear in the homework column if there is an issue with completing homework to a suitable standard or if it is not completed on time.

Excellent attendance is key to good progress and attainment. In light of this, your child's current attendance is included within the report.

We are proud of how our year 11 students have conducted themselves so far on their GCSE journey. The final stages of year 11 are crucial for your child to achieve the best grades possible.
