Teachers have used key marked piece assessments as well as classwork and homework to report on your child's attainment and progress. We look forward to discussing your child's progress in school and their report at parents evening later this week.

An explanation of the report is set out below:

The Report Breakdown:

- The Attitude to Learning (ATL) scores indicate your child's overall ATL in each subject area and ranges from a "1" (Exemplary) to a "4" (Often fails to meet expectations).
- Target indicates the band we would expect your child to be working at throughout the year. This target is based on their performance from Key Stage 2.
- Progress is colour coded and indicates how much progress your child has made in comparison to their target.
- "Yes" will appear in the homework column if there is an issue with completing homework to a suitable standard or if it is not completed on time.

Excellent attendance is key to good progress and attainment. In light of this, your child's current attendance is included within the report.
