Year 9 Historic Trip to Bletchley Park

To link with our Year 9 History Curriculum on the 20th Century, the History department at the King's School are extremely excited to announce that we will be running a trip to Bletchley Park.

Bletchley Park is known for its rich heritage, stunning architecture, and its association with the once top-secret home of the World War Two Codebreakers. Bletchley Park is now a vibrant heritage attraction which offers Immersive films, interactive displays, museum collections and faithfully recreated WW2 rooms that will guide you on a journey to discover the past at Bletchley Park. Exhibitions, set within beautifully restored historic buildings, tell the story of this once top-secret operation. The trip will take place on **Monday 29 April 2024** and includes entry fees, a guided tour of the park, an immersive workshop on Alan Turing, the Battle of the Atlantic and D-Day and all transportation costs. The price includes the cost of the visit and travel; and the cost of the trip is £32.75.

The coach will leave The King's School at approximately 6.45am and return to school at approximately 5.30pm. Students are NOT required to wear school uniform but must wear appropriate, respectful clothing.
