In order to continue this momentum and ensure that students achieve the best possible outcomes I am pleased to share more details of the sessions which will be running over half term from **Tuesday 28 to Friday 31 May.** You will already be aware of these as they are outlined on your child's personalised timetable which was given to your child on Friday 3 May so their attendance to these sessions is expected.

These sessions, primarily in Core Subjects, Spanish and History/Geography will focus on exam content, skills and technique and will provide a further invaluable opportunity to work with their teachers towards the final period of exams.

All sessions will run from 09.00am to 1.30pm with students having a 30 minute break at 11.00am. Students should enter the School via Gate 3 and will register in the deli before being escorted to specific classrooms by the teachers leading the sessions. We recommend that students bring a drink with them, and should they wish, any food for during their break. Students are not required to wear school uniform for these sessions.
