Year 11 Arrangements for Final Week

Dear Parents/Carers

As we approach the culmination of the academic year, I would like to extend my heartfelt congratulations to our Year 11 students for their dedication and hard work throughout the year and in particular the GCSE exam period. Their commitment to revision sessions and the examination schedule has been commendable and we are confident they will achieve fantastic results which are well deserved in August.

As you will have seen on the adjusted timetable, some students will today sit their final exam. However, for students who still have exams to sit next week I would like to remind you of the specific arrangements:

Monday 17 June

Students are only required to attend school if they are studying Design Technology (DT) or Music. All DT and Music students should arrive at the normal time of 8.25am. Music students will receive a revision booster session periods 1 to 3 before sitting their exam in the afternoon. They will be dismissed after their exam. All DT students will be in revision booster sessions periods 1 to 4 and will be dismissed from the site at 1:35pm.

Tuesday 18 June

All students who have a DT exam need to arrive on time at 8.25am for their examination. Students will be dismissed from school once this exam has finished.

Wednesday 19 June and Thursday 20 June

Students are only required to attend school if they are studying Hospitality & Catering. All Hospitality & Catering students should arrive to school at the normal time of 8.25am and will receive a revision booster session periods 1 to 4 and will be dismissed from site at 1.35pm. Students need to arrive at 8.25am on Thursday 20 June for their exam in this subject and they will be dismissed from the school once this exam has finished.

End of Year Celebrations

Leaver's Day is on Friday 21 June from 8.25am to 1pm. Invitations for this will be given to students who are eligible as they leave their last exam. Students will be required to bring

their invite to gain entry on the day. Hoodies will be distributed during this event if they have been purchased. Final details regarding the logistics of Leavers Day will be provided soon via MCAS.
