Year 10 End of Year Report

Please log in to your My Child At School (MCAS) account to view your child's end of year report. To access the report, please view the reports tab.

Teachers have used recent end of year assessments and key piece assessments completed throughout the year, as well as ongoing class work and homework to report on your child's attainment and progress.

An explanation of the report breakdown is set out below:

- The target indicates the minimum GCSE grade we expect your child to achieve at the end of Year 11.
- The realistic expected grade (REG) is the grade we think your child will achieve at the end of Year 11 based on assessments, classwork and their attitude to learning (ATL). The colour code indicates their progress towards achieving their target.
- The attitude to learning (ATL) scores indicate your child's ATL in each subject area and ranges from a "1" (Exemplary) to a "4" (Often fails to meet expectations).
- "Yes" will appear in the homework column if there is an issue with completing homework to a suitable standard or if it is not completed on time.

Excellent attendance is key to good progress and attainment. Therefore, your child's year to date attendance is included within the report.
